STAFF'S PROPOSAL FOR ACTION

Pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's ("ALJ") notice regarding her proposed decision, the staff submits the following Proposal for Action. The Staff requests that the Commissioner accept the ALJ's decision granting the Staff's Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment and denying Imaging Associates of Providence's (IAP) Motion for Summary Judgment. The net effect of accepting this decision is that IAP is an Independent Diagnostic Testing Facility and is required to obtain a CON for its imaging facilities in Wasilla and Anchorage facilities. Despite agreement with the ultimate conclusion, the Staff requests that the decision be amended as follows:

- 1. That any reference to the possible merit or success of an estoppel argument by IAP, should they apply for a CON and be denied, should be removed from the opinion as advisory. See, Jefferson v. Apslund, 458 P.2d 995, 1001-1002 (Alaska 1969).
- 2. Additionally, the decision should be amended to specifically address how to implement this decision by articulating what are the time frames for
