

**NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF NEED
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES**

The Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) has received an application for a certificate of need for the health care facility project described below.

Project/Activity: Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc. proposes to build a 73,120 square foot Specialty Clinics building. The project will add a 3.0 Tesla MRI, a PET/CT unit, and 2 endoscopy rooms. 6 oncology infusion bays will be added to the existing 6 bays as well as additional space for rehabilitation and specialty clinics of which some will be leased space. The estimated project cost is \$38,204,545. The estimated completion date is December 2015.

Applicant's Name: Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc

Project/Activity Service Area: Kenai Peninsula Borough

In accordance with 7 AAC 07.042 notice is hereby given that any person planning to submit a certificate of need application for similar activity in the same proposed service area must submit a letter of intent to the department no later than 4:30 PM, Monday July 29, 2013 so that the department may prepare to conduct a concurrent review of all applications.

The letter of intent must include

1. A clear, complete, and current description of the proposed activity, including a description of each component of the activity proposed to be undertaken;
2. An estimate of the total cost of the project; and
3. An estimated starting date and completion date for the proposed activity.

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To be reviewed concurrently, an application for a certificate of need for a similar service must be submitted within 60 days after the initial application for a service is declared complete. As soon as the initial application is declared complete, public notice will be issued and will include information on opportunities for public comment and the location where a copy of each certificate of need application may be reviewed.
