EXPANSION OF SOUTH PENINSULA HOSPITAL

ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER

In accordance with provisions of A.S. 18.07.031-111 and 7 AAC 07.010-130, it has been determined that the following components of the Certificate of Need application to expand and remodel South Peninsula Hospital (SPH) have met the applicable criteria for approval to the satisfaction of the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services: the emergency department with the exception of one exam room; the laboratory; imaging; admitting, registration, waiting area, drop-off, and parking; central sterile processing; pharmacy; dietary; housekeeping; laundry; materials management; medical records/health information management; relocation of the mobile MRI; purchase of minor equipment and furnishings; and utilities upgrades including new boilers and an oxygen generator. SPH is authorized to spend \$17,330,358 for remodeling and expansion of the South Peninsula Hospital with an approved completion date of December 31, 2009.
