**NOTICE OF ASSIGNMENT AND ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES**

On November 15, 2006, the Department of Health and Social Services referred to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) the appeal by Imaging Associates of Providence (IAP) concerning the department's conclusion that IAP's Abbott Road facility requires a certificate of need. Administrative Law Judge Terry L. Thurbon of OAH's Juneau office, who is hearing the appeal concerning IAP's Mat-Su Valley facility, is hereby assigned to this matter. The procedures in AS 44.62.330 – AS 44.62.630, AS 44.64.030 – AS 44.64.200, 2 AAC 64.100 – 2 AAC 64.990 and 7 AAC 07.080 apply to the hearing of this matter.



Documents filed by a party in this matter should refer to the consolidated cases using OAH No. 06-0743-DHS alone or using both case numbers, but the parties should not file duplicate documents under the separate case numbers. The existing file and the new referral file will be integrated into a single file and maintained under the 06-0743-DHS number.
