RE: Central Peninsula Hospital – Certificate of Need for Expansion and Renovation Project

Dear Mr. Davis,

The review of Central Peninsula Hospital's Certificate of Need application for the above referenced project is complete.

I have determined that the application has met the applicable criteria for approval to the satisfaction of the State of Alaska Department of Health and Social Services.

In accordance with A.S. 18.07.031-111 and 7 AAC 07.001-900, Central Peninsula Hospital's request for a Certificate of Need to expand and renovate its hospital is approved.

The Central Peninsula Hospital Phase VI Project is approved to expand and renovate approximately 28,727 Square Feet (SF) of new building floor area and 26,000 SF of renovated space. The project includes the addition of one service - cardiac catheterization laboratory; the expansion of two services – a three-bed addition to the Intensive Care Unit, and the Pharmacy; upgrade of an existing service - the Obstetrics Department, which will result in a bed re-classification; and an overall site upgrade and modernization.

The total project cost is estimated at \$26,918,933. Completion of the project is anticipated to be January of 2020.

Under 7 AAC 07.080, if you are dissatisfied with this decision, you are entitled to a hearing. The request for a hearing must be received in writing by the department no later than 30 days from the date of this letter.
