

How You Can Register

- 1.** Register at the CMS EHR Incentive Program Registration site at <https://ehrincentives.cms.gov/hitech/login.action>.
- 2.** Create a State Level Registry (SLR) account at <http://ak.arraincentive.com/>.
- 3.** Locate a copy of your signed contract with a vendor for the purchase, implementation or upgrade of a certified EHR system.
- 4.** Verify your EHR is certified and is on the list from ONC at <http://onc-chpl.force.com/ehrcert>.
- 5.** Eligible professionals must locate your active medical license number and Medicaid ID.
- 6.** Eligible hospitals must locate the most recent 4 years of cost report data.
- 7.** Determine your Medicaid patient volume you will be reporting.
- 8.** Determine which method of certified EHR technology you will be attesting, ADOPT, IMPLEMENT or UPGRADE.
- 9.** Complete the Eligibility workbook and Adopt/Implement/Upgrade Attestation workbook.
- 10.** Complete the application in the SLR and sign and complete your attestation.

Alaska Medicaid EHR Incentive Program

The State of Alaska has implemented as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) the Alaska Medicaid EHR Incentive Program which provides incentive payments to eligible professionals and eligible hospitals who adopt, implement, upgrade and meaningfully use certified EHR technology.

EHR Incentive Payments

Eligible professionals may be eligible to receive an incentive payment up to \$63,750 over six years. Eligible hospitals may receive millions over three years.

Eligible Professional Qualifications

- Do not perform 90% or more of their services in an inpatient hospital or emergency room hospital setting
- Have a minimum 30% Medicaid patient volume within a 90 - day period (20% requirement for pediatricians) based on Medicaid and total encounters
- Are a physician, advanced nurse practitioner, certified nurse midwife, dentist or physician assistant practicing in an FQHC or RHC led by a physician assistant

Eligible Hospital Qualifications

- Have a minimum 10% Medicaid patient volume within a 90-day period (no Medicaid patient volume requirement for children's hospitals) based on Medicaid and total encounters
- Are an acute care hospital, critical access hospital or children's hospital
